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FOREWORD

Babylonian Inscriptions in the Collection of James B. Nies at Yale University resumes publication, after a dozen years' interval, with this posthumous volume of copies prepared by the late Reverend Clarence Elwood Keiser.

Keiser was born October 12, 1884, in Lyons, Pennsylvania. He was a graduate of Muhlenberg College (B.A., 1905), the Lutheran Theological Seminary at Philadelphia (1908), University of Pennsylvania (M.A., 1910), and Yale University (Ph.D., 1912), and attended the University of Leipzig in the summer of 1911. He served as assistant curator of the Yale Babylonian Collection from 1913 to 1916, and as lecturer in Assyriology at Yale from 1919 to 1920. His later years were largely devoted to the ministry near his native Lyons, where he died on July 21, 1958.

In the short span of six years, Keiser published as many separate monographs, beginning with his doctoral dissertation which, after a preliminary notice in *The Museum Journal* for 1912, appeared in print in 1914 as the third volume of *Babylonian Records in the Library of J. Pierpont Morgan* (BRM). He edited the first two volumes in the present series (BIN): vol. 1 in 1917 (1918) and vol. 2 in 1920 (with J. B. Nies). In between (1919) he published three volumes in the Yale Oriental Series (YOS): Babylonian Texts, vol. 4; Researches, vol. 4/2; and the Appendix (all that ever appeared) to Researches, vol. 9. The last-named item, *A System of Accentuation for Sumero-Akkadian Signs*, was superseded by the subsequent systems of Thureau-Dangin and others, but the balance of his published work has retained all its original usefulness.

When Keiser left Yale in 1920, he had already prepared the first forty plates of the present volume. Together with the appropriate indices, these were submitted in 1934, when it was decided to expand the volume to include, as nearly as possible, all the Drehem texts then remaining unpublished in the Nies Babylonian Collection. From 1936 to 1940, Keiser prepared copies of these texts as they were sent to him for this purpose. For a number of years thereafter, he worked on the introductory matter in consultation with Ferris J. Stephens.

After Keiser's death, his entire manuscript was turned over to the Babylonian Collection by his son William. His copies proved to be accurate in almost every detail, but his descriptions of the texts had necessarily to be rewritten in the light of the continuing progress of neo-Sumerian studies. This work, entrusted to Shin Theke Kang, was completed in 1968-69 under a postdoctoral fellowship provided jointly by the Alexander Kohut Research Fellowship at Yale and the National Endowment for the Humanities.

INTRODUCTION

The present volume contains six hundred and twenty-seven economic texts from the Drehem archive dating to the time of the Third Dynasty of Ur.¹ All these texts are a part of the James B. Nies Babylonian Collection at Yale University. Although many economic texts from Drehem have been published, they are still a small part of what exists in the various collections, and there remain many difficulties and unsolved problems inherent in them.

Now this publication presents many additional materials for the study of the chronology, onomasticon, geography, religion, culture, and economic and social structure of the Ur III period, particularly with regard to the organization of the Drehem livestock complex.

Used in conjunction with other published texts, this volume affords deeper insight into the economic organization of Drehem so necessary for a better understanding of the Ur III documents.

As already known, the Drehem complex was a large government-operated livestock complex established by Šulgi. The government collected livestock from the people in the form of taxes to the government, gifts to the kings, offerings to the temples and booty from captured inhabitants. Therefore the government set up a central administrative livestock complex in Drehem for the maintenance and disposal of this livestock. For this purpose, men were appointed to collect the livestock from various regions and to care for them. Because of distance the government had to set up branches at various locations, but all records were kept at the central administration in Drehem.² For example, text 365 states that a gazelle was entrusted to Ašani'u, a government official, stationed at Tummal, who was responsible for the government property in his custody. In text 5, Ašani'u reports the death of this (?) gazelle to the Drehem authorities. Such meticulous record-keeping, including the names of pertinent officials and exact dates, enables us to view the activities of various officials in the economic life of Ur III period by gathering all relevant texts relating to these individuals. Only a few examples can be given here.

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THE ROLE OF WOMEN AT DREHEM

First, let us select those texts which deal with women and examine their roles in the economic and religious life of the Ur III period. There are queens (*nin*), princesses (*dumu-mí lugal*), kings' priestly wives (*lukur lugal*),³ priestesses (*en*, *nin-dingir*), daughters-in-law (?) (*é-gi₄-a*), midwives (*šà-zu*), and daughters (*dumu-mí*) and wives (*dam*) of the officials.

Harris pointed out in *JESHO* 6:122 ff, the function of *lukur* in the Ur III period is to be distinguished from that of *naditu* of the Old Babylonian period. Unlike the Old Babylonian *naditu* women, the *lukur* of the Ur III period did not constitute a separate community of women. Only a few *lukur* women are mentioned in Ur III texts and they appear to have been members of the administrative staff of the king. It appears that the *lukur* women were the very consort of the king while performing priestly functions (*MUNUS. IŠIB*) and may also have born children. This may perhaps be proven by the mention of the daughter of Kubatum (*dumu-mí Ku-ba-tum*) in *BIN III*, 571:54 which is dated to Šu-Sin 4. It is almost certain that Kubatum of this text is to be identified with Kubatum, the *lukur* of Šu-Sin (*UVB VIII*, p. 28). Professor J. J.

Women seem to have played very active and important economic roles in the Ur III period. In many cases, the transactions were between two women exclusively. They brought and received animals, especially animals for temple offerings. For example, Šulgi-simti, one of the most important women in the Ur III empire, was greatly involved in religious-economic affairs. As a *lukur* of Šulgi she gathered and delivered all the sacrificial animals under her authority (*mu-túm dŠulgi-simti*) for the temple.

The activities of Šulgi-simti stop at Šulgi 48 and the activities of another famous woman, Abi-simti,¹² begin from Amar-Sin 1. As in the case of Šulgi-simti the activities of Abi-simti are exclusively religious.

12. The relationship between Šulgi-simti and Abi-simti is not clear. Šulgi-simti is known to be the lukur of Šulgi (see Goetze, *JCS* 17:35). On the other hand, scholars differ as to the role of Abi-simti, who was described as nin in *SRD* 19 (AS 8); *TRU* 126

(AS 8); *UET* III, 1504, viii (IS 2); *UET* III, 1505, ix; and *SRT* 23. Abi-simti was Šulgi's wife, and mother of both Amar-Sin and Šu-Sin. However, Jacobsen (*JCS* 7:45 ff) on the basis of the same text (*SRT* 23) assumes that Abi-simti was the consort of

2. Abi-simti was also responsible for providing animals to the temple. During the reign of Amar-Sin, the early system of the Drehem complex had been changed.¹⁴ All the animals which formerly were gathered together and delivered on the authority of Šulgi-simti were now controlled directly by the officials of the Drehem complex. These animals were then disbursed to pre-arranged destinations. One of these destinations was to Abi-simti who then apparently distributed the received animals to the temple.

Amar-Sin and, after his death, of his brother and successor, Šu-Sin. If one accepts the interpretation of Falkenstein and Kramer (*ANET* 496), it is perhaps possible to discern the following relationship between Šulgi-simti and Abi-simti. The sources from Šulgi's reign do not mention his wife (dam or nin) by name; however, Šulgi-simti, his Lukur, is the dominant woman in Šulgi's reign. Since the title of Lukur does not exclude the position of wife and in fact Kubatum is known both as the Lukur of Šu-Sin (*UVB* VIII, 28) and nin of Šu-Sin (*SRT* 28), it is plausible to assume that Šulgi-simti was indeed the wife of Šulgi and mother of his sons, Amar-Sin and Šu-Sin (for the evidence of Lukur bearing children, see above n. 3). Hence Šulgi-simti would be identical with Abi-simti. This hypothesis is strengthened by the fact that Šulgi-simti's activity ends with Šulgi's death (*JCS* 17:35 f) while Abi-simti's activity begins

in the first year of Šulgi's successor, Amar-Sin. Thus Šulgi-simti would have continued in her office as a dowager queen during the reign of her sons under the name of Abi-simti. The changing of names (see Goetze *JCS* 17:9) in the Ur III period is, on certain occasions, not an uncommon phenomenon. If the interpretation of Jacobsen proves to be correct, positive identification between Šulgi-simti and Abi-simti may not be established. It may also be possible that Abi-simti was the daughter of Šulgi who then married her brother. This would be a parallel situation to the Ur III marriage of Ibbit-Sin to his sister, Gema-Enlilla (*JCS* 7:37).

Second, there is one text (505) which is worthy of special attention since it may serve as valuable material for dating the year formula: mu En-nam-šita_x-^aŠul-gi-ra-ke₄-ba-gub ba-hun. This year formula which appears only seven times (EAH 108:109; UET III, 289:290; 6N-T, 147*; 6N-T, 850*; Smith Coll. 555*) has still not been definitely

identified.¹⁵ Thureau-Dangin (*SAKI* p. 235, 6 h) and Legrain (*UET III*, p. 276) believed that this year formula belonged to Šulgi's reign.¹⁶ Ungnad more specifically placed it in the first year of Šulgi (*RLA II*, p. 140, 21) and Schneider virtually accepted this suggestion (*AnOr XIII*, p. 13). Since the year formula contains the divine determinative before Šulgi's name, Kraus (*OrNS 20*, p. 387) could not accept Ungnad's placing of the year in the early part of Šulgi's reign. Therefore he identified it with Šulgi 47 on the basis of Schneider, *Or 18* (1925), p. III, n. 10 (= *Or 45–46:24*, n. 1). On the other hand, Sollberger (*AfO 17:16 f*) preferred to consider this year formula as a simple variant formula of Šulgi 29 and identified her with the high priestess of Enki who, in his judgment, continued to serve in this capacity until Amar-Sin 8. Additional evidence was marshalled by Goetze (*Iraq 22:153 ff*) to support Sollberger's suggestion.

However, the occurrences of *En-nam-šita_x-^dŠul-gi-ra-ke₄-ba-gub* in our text 505 together with *Or 18:III*, n. 10 (= *Or 45–46:24*, n. 1) and Bucc. pl. VIII, vii raise doubts about Sollberger's identification of this year formula with Šulgi 29. These texts show that *En-nam-šita_x-^dŠul-gi-ra-ke₄-ba-gub* was active in the last years of Šulgi and in the reign of Amar-Sin.

Smith Coll. 555, published by Goetze in *Iraq 22:157* may need to be reinterpreted to mean that *mu Ha-ar-ši^{ki} ba-ḥul* and *mu-ús-sa En-nam-šita_x-^dŠul-gi-ra-ke₄-ba-gub ba-ḥun* were variant names of the identical year. In that case, the formula *mu En-nam-šita_x-^dŠul-gi-ra-ke₄-ba-gub ba-ḥun* necessarily would be a (variant) name of the year *before* *mu Ha-ar-ši^{ki} ba-ḥul* (Š 27 or 48) and could not be equated with the year *mu en Eridu^{ki}-ga ba-ḥun-gá* (Š 28) as proposed by Sollberger and Goetze.¹⁷ Instead we may have to reckon with the possibility that *mu En-nam-šita_x-^dŠul-gi-ra-ke₄-ba-gub ba-ḥun* is a variant for the date *mu-ús-sa Kima^{ki} ba-ḥul*, i.e. Šulgi 47. Her appearance in at least two texts dated to this year lends credence to this suggestion.

REGISTER AND DESCRIPTION OF THE TEXTS

As may be seen from the "Register and Description of the Texts" (below), the first 40 plates of autographed texts were arranged in three groups on the basis of their dates: the first and largest (1–264), in chronological order; the second (265–310), dated by "ambiguous" formulas; the third and smallest (312–320), lacking any (preserved) date. Today it would be possible to date most of the second group with virtual certainty, but the original arrangement has been retained.

Under "Reign": Š, Šulgi; AS, Amar-Sin; ŠS, Šu-Sin; IS, Ibbi-Sin.

Under "Year" the numbers and letters refer to those in the year formula lists published by N. Schneider in *Analecta Orientalia* 13 (1936). Since Schneider assumed a reign of forty-six years for Šulgi, all Šulgi dates should be raised by three to conform to Ungnad's system in *Reallexikon der Assyriologie II*, p. 139 ff, or by two to conform to the forty-eight years that Šulgi is at present generally assumed to have reigned.
